TREASURER'S REPORT - 1981 SEASON

We were able to play rather more games than usual, and hence our match-fee income was somewhat greater than in previous years, as the accompanying accounts show. I am grateful to Colin Warbrick for collecting the fees in the latter part of the season when I was unable to play.

Our only expenditure was on the replacement of worn equipment, and so we achieved a surplus of £17.04 on the year. There thus seems to be no reason to increase the match fee of 50p, which has remained unchanged for 8 seasons.
