1. Apologies

2. Minutes of Last Meeting

6. Captain's Report

There was no Captain's report following the departure of the 1985 Captain, John Sandbach, to Reading. It was agreed that the Secretary should write to John expressing the Club's appreciation of his efforts on behalf of the Club in the last few years.

7. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer presented the accounts which showed a balance in hand at 10/3/86 of £76.31. The wisdom of raising match fees to £1 in 1985 was clearly seen. The Treasurer also presented the equipment list and explained that the wear on cricket balls from use in the indoor net was causing some concern. The Chairman said he would inquire whether any saving could be made by purchasing via Durham City or Durham County Cricket Clubs.

8. Secretary's Report

The Secretary reported that his predecessor Rob Foley had left the files in good order. A provisional fixture list for 1986 was tabled. It was agreed to suggest a date in early July for the match against the City Councillors. The Secretary agreed to contact Newcastle re. the inter-University tournament as it was important to know the dates and details as early as possible so that team members could keep dates free.

9. Any Other Business

A new wicket is being laid at Maiden Castle in 1986 and some problems may arise regarding allocation of pitches. The Captain agreed to attend a meeting at Maiden Castle on 12/3/86 when this problem was to be discussed and would make adjustments to the 1986 fixture list as necessary.
